Amatola Water invites quotations from suitably qualified and experienced service providers for the Installation and Configuration of Biometric Access Control System, ad-hoc Maintenance and Support at Amatola Water Offices.

SCOPE OF WORK

1. PURPOSE

Amatola Water wishes to engage a competent service provider to enter into a service level agreement for the provision of a reliable, efficient, compliant, biometric access control system and time and attendance system that integrates into the payroll administration system.

2. BACKGROUND

Amatola Water has a Biometric Access Control system that was installed in 2016 at its Head Office in East London. The organisation has 7 entrances/exits at Head Office that are

monitored and controlled by the system. Each entrance has a biometric fingerprint reader and controller that employees use to access the building. There are zoned areas within the building where only specific employees can access. The organisation is looking for a qualified service provider that will be able to replace the biometric access control system and integrate the current existing biometric equipment, biometric readers and scanners.

3. OBJECTIVES AND GOALS

The objective of the project is for replacing Door Controllers and installation of Paxton Net2 software for 7 doors. The current access control system must be integrated with the current biometric equipment (biometric readers, Maglocks, Green Break Glasses, Network Points and Biometric Take on Reader and provide a system will have time and attendance and integrate to the payroll system. The system must be installed in such a way that it can be expanded to the other regional offices should the organisation have such a requirement.
