Only tenderers who are registered with the CIDB or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading of 3CE or higher and those who satisfy the criteria stated in the tender data, will be eligible to tender.

BID PUBLICATION

Bid documents will be available from **10:00am on Monday, 31 October 2022** at Reception at Amatola Water, 6 Lancaster Road, Vincent, East London and then during working hours between 08:00 – 16:00 until one week after Compulsory Bid Clarification Meeting. **A non-refundable fee of R500.00 is payable for each set of bid documents. Payment is to be made by either bank deposit or Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) only (no cash or cheque payments will be accepted) and is to be made payable to Amatola Water, Nedbank, Account No. 1210394685,**

Branch Code, 198765. The proof of deposit is required upon collection of the tender documents. No tender documents will be sold at the briefing meeting.

COMPULSORY BID CLARIFICATION MEETING

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place at La Grange Senior Secondary School at Matatiele. (30°11'43.7" South 28°42'25.7" East) on the 7th November 2022 at 11:00am for La Grange Senior Secondary School, Sive Special School, and Mosa Sibi Senior Secondary School.

A separate compulsory clarification meeting will be held at Nolitha Special School in Mount Ayliff. (30°48'04.3" South 29°22'23.2" East) on the 8th November 2022 at 11:00am for Nolitha Special School. Any bidder who arrives more than 15 minutes after the proposed meeting time, shall not be allowed to enter and participate in the clarification meeting.

NB: There will be separate attendance registers for each bid and each bidder may only represent one company per bid as there will be a rollcall conducted at the end of the briefing sessions.

Prospective tenderers that do not attend the compulsory clarification meeting will not be allowed to tender and will be viewed as non-compliant.

BID CONDITIONS

- The 2017 Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000 (PPPFA) principles shall apply, whereby submissions will be evaluated accordingly to the provisions of the Act.
 - Broad Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) Status will be scored in accordance with the DTI Codes of Good Practice and bidders must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level certificate or a certificate issued by a registered auditor, accounting officer (as contemplated in section 60 (4) of the Closed Corporation Act, 1984) or an accredited verification agency in order to be eligible for B-BBEE points.
 - Amatola Water does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept any tender or portion of a tender.
1. Tenders which are late, incomplete, unsigned or submitted electronically will not be accepted.
 2. All tenders are to remain valid for a period of 12 weeks from the closing date of the submission.
 3. A Tax Compliance status PIN (an original valid SARS certificate) must be submitted with the tender document to be considered.
 4. Failure to provide supplementary information specified and completion of the returnable schedules will result in the tender being regarded as non-responsive.
 5. Tender Forms (Form C1.1: Form of Offer and Acceptance) that are incomplete or incorrectly completed will result in the disqualification of the tender.
 6. SBD 4 – Bidders Disclosure must be fully completed and signed

PREFERENTIAL PROCUREMENT POLICY FRAMEWORK ACT NO. 5, 2000 (PPPFA) WILL BE APPLIED AS FOLLOWS:

In terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000, Preferential Procurement Regulation 2017, Subcontracting as a Condition of Tender, as specified in Regulation 9 will apply.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The 80/20 preference points system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 Pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, (ACT No 5 of 2000) (PPPFA) will be applied to evaluate all bids. The lowest acceptable bid will score 80 points for price and a maximum of 20 points will be awarded depending on the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (B-BBEE) Status Level of Contribution. Bids received will be evaluated in two (4) stages, namely Determine Completeness of Tender Offer, Local Content, Capability requirements and compliance assessment and Price and Preference.

BID SUBMISSION

The original completed bid documents and all supporting documents (in a separate file), must be submitted in a sealed envelope or parcel endorsed with the Bid Number and Bid Description as detailed in the Tender Data. The sealed envelope must be deposited in the Bid/Tender Box located in the reception area of **Amatola Water, 6 Lancaster Rd, Vincent, East London**, prior to the time and date indicated in the bid notice and the Tender Data. The bid submissions will be opened in public shortly the closing time.
