Only tenderers who are registered with the CIDB or are capable of being so prior to the evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to or higher than a contractor grading of 8 CE and those who satisfy the criteria stated in the tender data, will be eligible to tender.

COMPULSORY BID CLARIFICATION MEETING

A compulsory clarification meeting with representatives of the Employer will take place on Thursday, 03 April 2025 at 11:00 am. The meeting will be held at the James Kleynhans Water Treatment Works (Co-Ordinates: 33° 11' 45.06" S; 26° 39' 44.70" E). Any bidder who arrives 15 minutes after the commencement of the tender briefing will not be allowed to participate in the clarification meeting.

Prospective tenderers should read the tender document prior to the meeting and must bring the original tender document to the clarification meeting so that the Proof of Attendance page can be signed. Participants attending the briefing are to be duly authorised to attend the clarification meeting on behalf of the tenderer. No bid documents will be sold at the clarification meeting. Those parties arriving more than 15 minutes after the actual commencement of the briefing will not be allowed to sign the Attendance Register and Returnable Schedule A2. Prospective tenderers that do not attend the compulsory clarification meeting will not be allowed to tender and will be viewed as non-compliant.

BID CONDITIONS

- Specific Goals will be used as the preference mechanism in accordance with the November 2022 Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Regulations (PPPFR) principles shall apply, whereby submissions will be evaluated accordingly to the provisions of the Regulations. Refer to SBD 6.1 for further details.
- Amatola Water does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept any tender or portion of a tender.
- Tenders which are late, incomplete, unsigned or submitted electronically will not be accepted.
- All tenders are to remain valid for a period of 12 weeks from the closing date of the submission.
- In terms of the Construction Industry Development Board Standard for Uniformity in Engineering and Construction Works Contracts-August 2019, subcontracting as a condition of tender shall apply as per the amended Clause C.2.26.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

The 90/10 preference points system as prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 will be applied to evaluate all bids.

BID PUBLICATION

Bid documents will be available from **09h00 on 27 March 2025** at the Reception at Amatola House, 6 Lancaster Road, Vincent, East London during working hours between 08h00 – 16h00. **A non-refundable fee of R750.00 is payable for each set of bid documents. No tender documents will be sold at the briefing meeting.
